Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001, as amended by Article 17 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2006, of the following proposed development:

**Location**

- in the village of Mulranny, Westport.

**Description of the proposed development**

- Construction of 180m of concrete footpath south of the N59 National Secondary Road at the Western end of Mulranny.
- Construction of 450m of concrete footpath north of the N59 National Secondary Road through the village of Mulranny.
- Provision of an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing
- Construction of a car park
- Construction of a retaining wall, north of the N59 National Secondary Road, at Ch570 and Ch 850
- Closing of the existing junction between the N59 National Secondary Road and the L1404-0 Local Road, for vehicles and the provision of a pedestrian access
