

FORM FOR REGISTRATION AS A EUROPEAN ELECTOR

[section 6 of the European Parliament Elections Act 1997]

NOTES

1. This form must be completed by EU citizens living in Ireland who wish to be registered to vote at European elections, other than the following :
 - Irish and British citizens, and
 - EU citizens who were registered to vote in Ireland at the 1994, 1999 or 2004 European elections.
2. The completed form should be returned to **Mayo County Council, Áras an Chontae, Castlebar, Co. Mayo.**
3. The information contained in this form will be forwarded to your home Member State to guard against double voting at the election.
4. A person who votes at a European election in Ireland and in another Member State is guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding €3,174.35 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or both.
5. A person who knowingly makes a false or misleading statutory declaration is liable on conviction to the penalty set out for such an offence at the time the offence was committed.
