(01) Minutes

The Minutes of the Meeting of the PMC (On Shore Pipeline) held on 18th September 2013 which had already been circulated, were proposed by Ms. Reynolds, seconded by Mr. Cosgrove and agreed.

(02) Matters Arising

(03) Progress Report – Developer

Ms. Reynolds informed the meeting that Mr. Draaisma has moved to another position within SEPIL and then introduced Mr. Borsboom and Mr. Moyles.

- **Construction Work**

Mr. Moyles informed the meeting of the position in relation to construction works undertaken in September and October 2013 as set out in report circulated.

- **Environmental Management**

Ms. Reynolds outlined the position in relation to environmental management for the September/October 2013 period, as set out in report circulated.

Mr. Keating also outlined details of the County Council's Community Futures Programme and indicated that contact is being made with various Groups within the Kilcommon area with a view to the Programme culminating in a Plan for the parish.

The Community Representatives thanked Mr. Keating, Mayo County Council and SEPIL for their input to the Programme.
