This mobile unit can be secured in-doors and is available to any school, business or association that would like to facilitate **FREE** WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment) collections.

## The Cage comes with...

- A supply of battery recycling boxes (which help generate funds for the Laura Lynn charity for each battery that is recycled - [www.lauralynn.ie](http://www.lauralynn.ie)).
- A box for CFL and energy saving light bulbs.
- If required a box for fluorescent tubes.

## What can go into the Cage?

- The cages are designed for small electrical appliances e.g. computers, toasters, kettles, DVD players, hairdryers, toys etc. See [www.weeeireland.ie](http://www.weeeireland.ie) for more details.
- We accept “anything with a plug or a battery from the household”. We will not accept business to business equipment or items deemed for professional use e.g. mainframe servers, professional catering equipment, laboratory equipment etc.
- Any larger electrical items such as televisions, washing machines, fridges etc can be left alongside the cage for collection.
