location, subject to the follow	

1. A fee, calculated on the basis of €125.00 (one hundred and twenty five euro) per month of scaffold being in place (erected) up to a maximum of €1,250.00 (one thousand, two hundred and fifty euro) shall be deposited with Mayo County Council, in compliance with Article 202 and Schedule 12, Part 1(c) of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001, (SI No. 600 of 2001) and Section 254 of the Planning & Development Act, 2000.

- 2. The applicant shall produce adequate Public Liability Insurance and shall indemnify Mayo County Council against any loss or injury, which may be caused during the time the scaffolding or hoarding is in place.
- 3. The scaffolding or hoarding shall be erected by persons that are competent in this area of works and all operations, (including erecting and subsequent dismantling of the scaffolding or hoarding) shall be carried out in accordance with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations, 2006, including any amendments thereof.
- 4. The public thoroughfare shall be kept open at all times for public passage.
- 5. In cases where the scaffold or hoarding will encroach upon the public footpath to the extent that the width of the footpath is reduced to less than 1.2m, a separate protected walkway (min. height 2.1m) shall be constructed for pedestrians.
- 6. Adequate signage shall be erected advising the public of any footpath restrictions, diversions, hazards, etc.
- 7. In cases where the scaffold or hoarding will encroach upon the public highway (street) such as might restrict traffic lane widths or on-street parking provisions, the applicant shall consult and seek the agreement of the relevant authority, Mayo County Council.
