

Cemetery Masses (Weather Permitting)

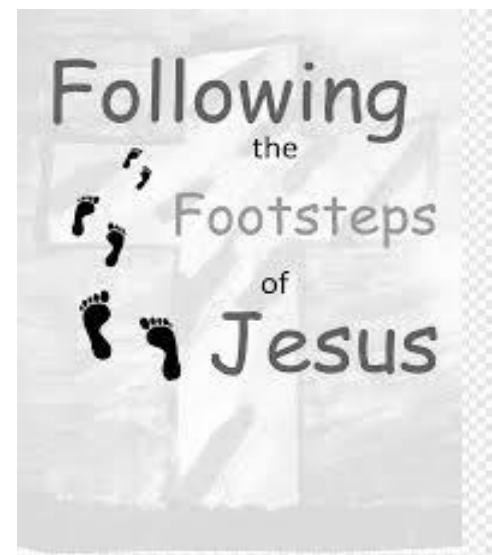
