Feast of St. Blaise: Thursday is the feast of St. Blaise - a blessing of throats will take place at morning mass.

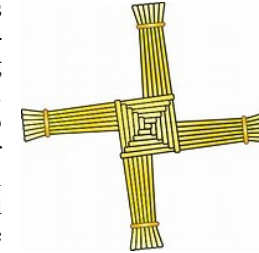
