A Word of thanks...On the 16th of October, in response to Pope Francis' invitation, we launched the Synodal Journey in our Diocese. Over the past number of months, I invited parishioners to respond to questions linked with their experience of the Church today. I was heartened by the responses that came back through written and online submission as well as those who attended the four Cluster area meetings. The responses have now been collated and a report has been written. It is available to view on www.achonrydiocese.org. The report has been submitted to the Synod Steering Committee and will form part of a national response which will be submitted to Rome. I wish to thank all who took the time to participate in any way. I express my deepest gratitude to the three members of the Diocesan Pastoral Leadership Team: Maeve Leheny, Bill Carthy and Fr. Eugene Duffy who put many hours into the process to see it come to fruition.
