

## National Heritage Week

**Irishtown Heritage Group** are organising a celebration event on **Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> August**, in honour of uilleann piper Michael Carney (1872–1938), a native of Irishtown, who was one of the most popular musicians of his era in New York.

**This is a full day event starting at 12noon with a two-hour: 'Try the Pipes' workshop facilitated by Emmett Gill and Cormac Cannon- Na Píobairí Uilleann.**

This will be An opportunity to learn about the uilleann pipes and to try out the instrument for yourself with the help of Na Píobairí Uilleann.

- **Exhibition and Film screening on the life and times of Michael Carney.** First screening of the latest film documentary (30 minutes) from the Irish Traditional Music Archive (ITMA) in its acclaimed '*Drawing from the Well*' series. It features the life and music of 'the Irishtown piper', Michael Carney, and is presented by renowned Galway uilleann piper Pádraic Keane.
- **Unveiling of a commemorative plaque honouring Michael Carney - by Christopher Carney, California, U.S.A.** (grandnephew of Michael Carney.)
- **Launch of Booklet – The Irishtown Piper - *The live and musical world of Michael Carney - 1872- 1938 of Brooklyn*, Author Michael Kelly.**
- **Mass in the Church of The Holy Family and Saint Oliver, Irishtown where Michael Carney and his family will be remembered.**
- **Live session by Musicians and Pipers till late. Full details will be on Facebook page called "Irishtown Community".**
- ***The afternoon events will be live streamed to New York, where Michael Carney became famous as an Uilleann Piper, Teacher and Pipe Maker. Venue - Connolly's Pub, Times Square, New York, U.S.A. (to join fellow pipers and musicians – U.S. local time 11.00am)***
