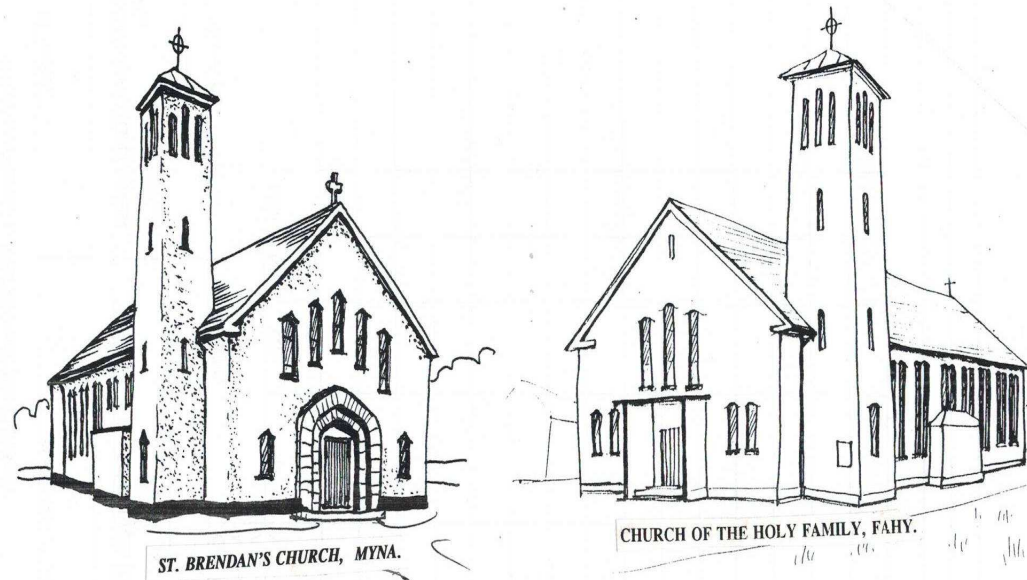
The Annual Church Gate Collection will be held in Fahy on this Saturday evening 29th October and in Myna on this Sunday the 30th of October.

PARISH NEWS:

FEASTS OF THE WEEK:

All Saints' Day. Next Tuesday (1st November) is the feast of All Saints and a holyday of obligation.

All Souls' Day. Wednesday, 2nd November is All Souls' Day.

Thursday: **St. Malachy.** He was born near Armagh in 1094. He became Archbishop of Armagh. He brought the Cistercians and Canons Regular into Ireland. He died in 1148.

Friday: **St Charles Borromeo, bishop (1538-1584),** He was made Cardinal Archbishop of Milan at 21 years. He drafted the Catechism of the Council of Trent.
