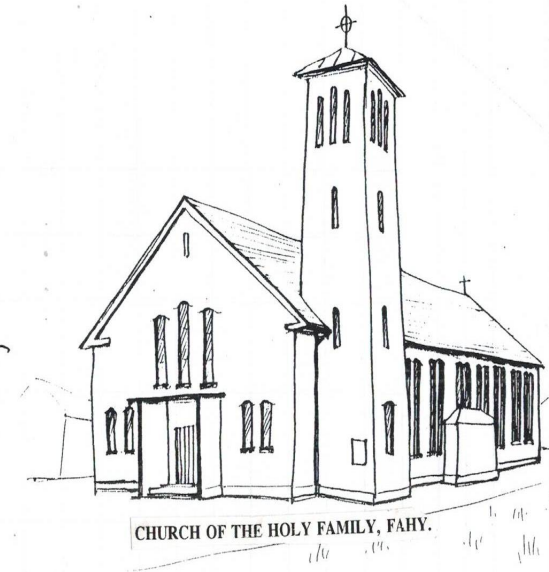

BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT MEETINGS:

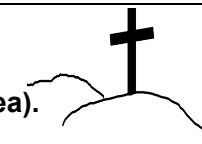
