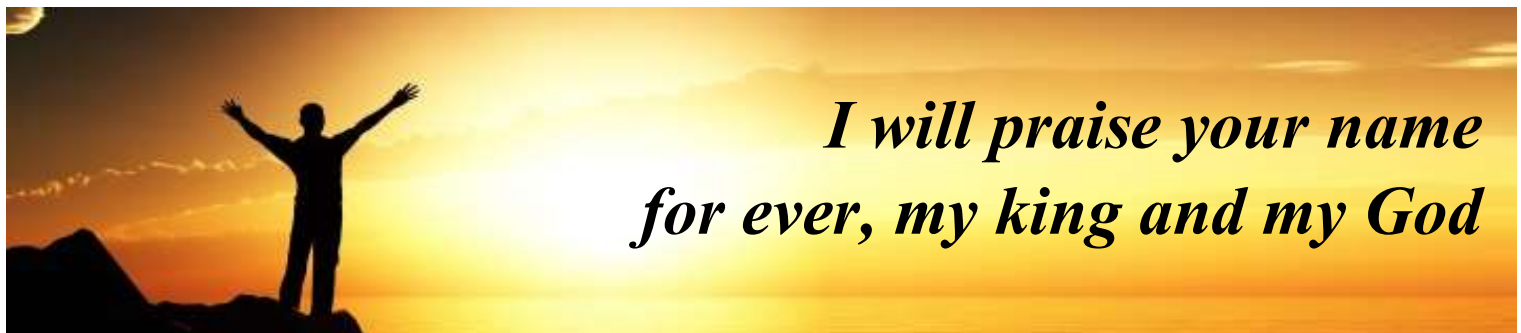

## World Day for Grandparents & Elderly July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023

In 2022, Pope Francis inaugurated the first 'World Day for Grandparent & the Elderly' to draw attention to the role and contribution grandparents and the elderly make to society, community, and family. This year the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be on **23<sup>rd</sup> July, 20-23**.

In preparation for this, the pastoral council have organised a number of things:

- Parishioners are invited to remember grandparents & elderly by including them in the parish **Book of Remembrance**. Forms are available in church porches & after Mass. They may be returned via collection box. If you have completed forms last year already, there is no need to complete a form for that person again. They will be remembered at Masses during World Day for Grandparents & Elderly.
- Postcards are available in church porches. The pastoral council are inviting parishioners and visitors, especially children to take a postcard and write a short note to their grandparents, aunts, uncles, elderly neighbours or friends and post it. It is always uplifting to receive post, especially those in hospital and/or nursing homes.
- Prayer cards are available in church porches, with a prayer for grandparents & elderly. Parishioners and visitors are invited to take these and place them in their prayer space and/or public place such as the kitchen so they may say the prayer.
- Colour sheets are available in church porches. Parishioners and visitors, especially children, are invited to take these sheets, colour them in and give them to grandparents and/or elderly. They are ideal for putting up on the fridge door!



Alongside this, the Pastoral Council are hoping to have a **special Mass** in each church where grandparents, children and grandchildren are involved. In our busy world, often of our own making, the danger can be to forget or push aside those who have contributed, sacrificed and brought us to where we are today. The objective of this weekend is to draw attention and remind us of the role grandparents and elderly have in our lives, and to take some time to pray for them, thank them personally and thank God for their presence in our lives. The pastoral council would like to invite you to the **special Masses that weekend – Glencorrib, Saturday July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 6:30pm & Shrle, Sunday July 23<sup>rd</sup> 11am.**

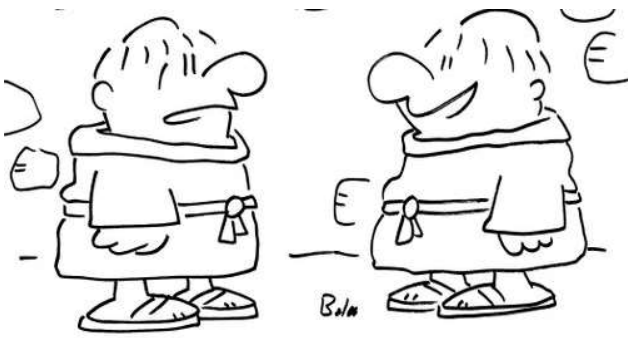

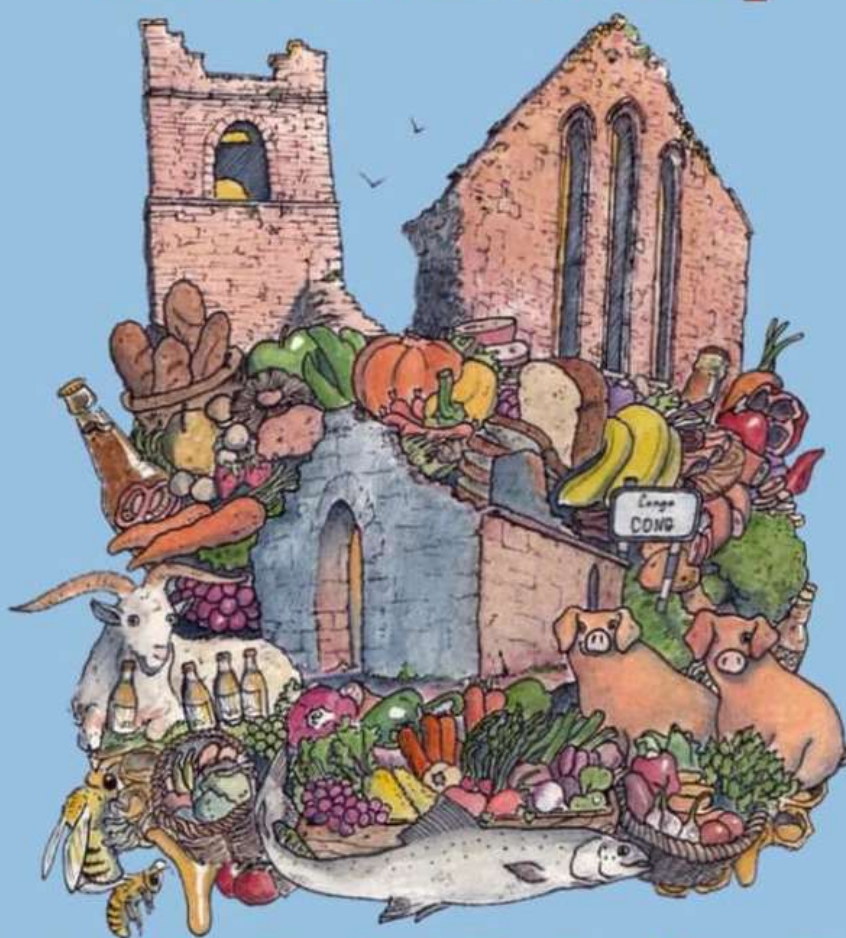
